This a great opportunity for the volunteers to gain exposure to fresh perspectives, ideas, and approaches, to develop professionally and personally, to hone their leadership/coaching skills and provide valuable cross-cultural insight in a real-life setting.

SUMMARY OF POSITION

This program offers mentorship services to enhance the career and academic readiness of young immigrant women ages 18-29. Through one-on-one mentorship volunteers will support young immigrant women gain job search strategies, build professional networks and acquire the tools necessary to secure employment in their field of expertise. Minimum time commitment is one hour per week with flexible meeting times for 2-3 months

- Report mentoring activities and volunteer hours to supervising staff

- Help the clients to develop new skills and knowledge
- Guide the clients on understanding their profession in a Canadian context
- Increase the mentee's familiarity with industry and occupation specific information
