SUMMARY OF POSITION

Camp activities, ages of youth, and location will change according to the various camps. Ages vary from 10-24 pending on the program needs. Camps run weekday, daytimes in July and August generally between the hours of 10:00am-4:00pm.

DUTIES AND STANDARDS OF PERFORMANCE

- Attend all trainings as necessary
- Interact and engage with youth at all times
- Provide leadership, co-facilitate, and/or promote youth participation
- Help with set up and clean up
- Supervise youth to ensure their safety
- Willing to be outdoors for the whole day
- Must be a committed volunteer all for the entire summer camp
- Demonstrate a high level of initiative and enthusiasm
- Maintain confidentiality and professionalism at all times
- Follow instructions provided by CIWA staff

QUALIFICATIONS

- Be able to work with youth of diverse backgrounds
- Experience working with youth is an asset but not mandatory
- Volunteers should be warm, friendly, patient, engaged, flexible and enthusiastic
- Awareness and sensitivity toward immigrant youth needs and concerns
- Strong communication skills
- First aid appreciated but not required
